Sports Program

Background

KTCEA supports and encourages participation of students in sporting activities within the school and in sporting competitions with other schools regionally, nationally, or internationally. School sport strengthens the education of students and school athletics and are an extension of the classroom. Sports programs teach life lessons and values such as citizenship, sportsmanship, teamwork, hard work and healthy lifestyles.

The emphasis on athletics in schools should be to empower students with the necessary skills that will allow them to be productive citizens.

1.	 Intramural Sports Activities 1.1 KTCEA approves of the school participating in the following scheduled intramural sports activities: a. Basketball b. Volleyball c. Track and Field d. Badminton e. Cross Country Running f. Traditional Indigenous games or sports 1.2 Prior approval of KTCEA shall be obtained if the school desires to participate in sports activities that are not part of the regular Physical Education program. Attempts shall be made to align the Physical Education program with course instruction. 1.3 Prior approval of the Superintendent is required if an activity impacts upon school-time. 1.4 Teachers signed up to oversee extra-curricular sports related activities can use this time as their 100 hours volunteer time. 2	 Intramural requirements Transportation Book KTCEA transportation one week or more prior to the game or tournament. 2.2 Food Place request to KTCEA Food Services one week or more prior to the game or tournament. Each school is responsible for student water bottles. 	School Staff
