High School Course Challenge Assessments

Background

Course challenge is a program that allows senior high school students to challenge the expectations for the course by participating in a formal assessment process, rather than taking the course. Course challenge is for students who believe that they already possess the expected knowledge, skills, and attitudes as defined by the Program of Studies for a given course.
