Update on Staff Recruitment/gaps (school by school):

- There is a career fair on September 21, currently we have a gap of 11 positions.

Cree Language:

Learning Bird Project Update

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School Foods Presentation

- School menus are planned on a monthly basis, cooks maintain inventory and order food to match upcoming month. Manager reviews and approves all orders.
- Delivery alternatives have been examined. Using KTCEA drivers we have more control although repairs and maintenance can increase costs.
