

## POWERSCHOOL CYBERSECURITY INCIDENT

On Thursday, January 9, we were informed of an International cybersecurity incident involving a PowerSchool support portal (PowerSource). The breach impacted dozens of Alberta school divisions and hundreds more across North America.

On January 16, 2025, PowerSchool confirmed a data breach which included Kee Tas Kee Now Tribal Council Education Authority (KTCEA). The breach affected current and former KTCEA Student and Staff information stored in the PowerSchool Student Information System.

We recognize the critical importance of protecting personal information, and we want to assure you that this matter is being treated with the utmost seriousness. PowerSchool has informed us that they are actively implementing enhanced security measures and are working closely with law enforcement to address this situation.

Kee Tas Kee Now Tribal Council Education Authority is fully committed to transparency and will share updates as soon as more information becomes available. These updates can be found on the News section of our website KTCEA.ca.
