



7. Staff who may have had direct close contact with the classroom with a positive case, MUST self-isolate for 14 days and be tested. Staff identified as a close contact may only return to the school once the isolation period is over, a negative test result is received, and they are not displaying any COVID-19 symptoms.
8. KTCEA Communications will update the KTCEA social media pages including the website to notify families of positive case in their child's school. No personal information will be shared.
9. The Health and Safety Coordinator and the Principal will work with the Director of Health to confirm if there are siblings, other KTCEA students or employees who reside in the same household as the individual who has tested positive and who attends or works in another KTCEA facility.
10. The Nations Community Health Centre and/or AHS if applicable, will conduct the contact tracing of the close contacts and provide notification of a positive case has been identified and assist them with the next steps including, self-isolation guidelines, monitoring for symptoms and to be tested. KTCEA will assist with the process and provide contact information when necessary.
11. Any close contacts (siblings, students and/or employees who reside in the same household) will be required to self-isolate for 14 days and be tested.
12. The Health and Safety Coordinator will work with the Transportation Manager and Operations and Maintenance Manager for cleaning protocols and transportation implications.
13. KTCEA will notify parents and the community once the school(s) are ready to re-open to students.
